The youth in our program come from a variety of backgrounds and experiences, though the majority come from low-income, single parent families or have a parent in prison.

What do Site-Based Matches Do?

You and your Little will meet after school to, play outside, do arts & crafts, play games, do homework and talk.

How Will One Hour a Week Make a Difference?

School-based mentoring is not a tutoring program. However, research has shown that of all children matched with a Big in school:

58% improved their school performance

65% showed higher levels of self-confidence

55% had a better attitude toward school
