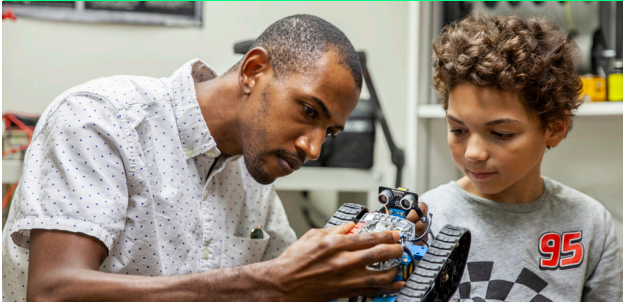
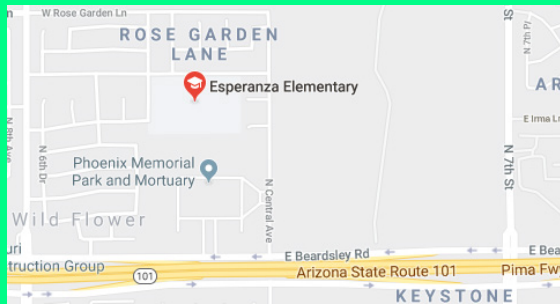


Meet with your Little Brother or Little Sister once a week to hang out, play games and talk.

School-based mentoring is not a tutoring program. However, research has shown that of all children matched with a Big in school:

- 58% improved their school performance
- 65% showed higher levels of self-confidence
- 55% had a better attitude toward school
